The Colony Club Tennis and Pickleball Center *Rules and Regulations*

- 1) Full Colony Club Members may reserve either tennis or pickleball courts. Tennis Members may reserve tennis courts only. Court reservations may be made Monday-Friday 6:00am-8:00pm and Saturday and Sunday 7:00am-8:00pm. Reservations may be made at The Colony Club front desk or by calling (650) 712-7868. No standing reservations will be accepted. The names of all players are required for court reservations.
- 2) Court reservations may be made seven (7) days in advance. Members may book only one court per reservation. No back-to-back bookings will be permitted by the same players. Reservations may be for a maximum of 90 minutes for singles play and 120 minutes for doubles play. Upon completion of your reserved court time, you are welcome to continue playing if the court is still available.
- 3) Members must check in and register at The Colony Club up to ten (10) minutes after the start of their scheduled time or the court will be released to the first name on the waiting list. Court reservations should be cancelled at least two (2) hours ahead of the scheduled time to avoid a charge of \$20.
- 4) At the end of their reservation time, members must promptly relinquish their court to the next member assigned to that court. All players are responsible for the cleanliness of their court during and after play. Once the member is off the court, he or she may sign-up for the next available court time.
- 5) Ball Machine reservations may be made Monday-Sunday 8:00am-7:00pm. The ball machine may be reserved at any time (for use on court 3 only) for up to 90 minutes. Players who are sixteen (16) years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult at all times while using the ball machine. When finished, place remote in control box, pick up all tennis balls and refill the ball machine for the next user.
- 6) In order to keep the court conditions and playing atmosphere appropriate, thank you for adhering to standard etiquette and strictly avoiding the use of the following: cutoff shorts or t-shirts, revealing or otherwise inappropriate clothing, shoes with marking soles, skateboards, bicycles, glassware, pets, rollerblades, roller skates, excessive noise, profanity or inappropriate behavior.
- 7) All players ten (10) years of age and younger must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- 8) All borrowed equipment must be checked-in and checked-out appropriately through The Colony Club.
- 9) Use of the courts shall be subject to the control of the Tennis and Pickleball Director at all times. Courts may be closed when necessary for maintenance or when dictated by safety considerations such as adverse or anticipated weather conditions. The Tennis and Pickleball Director may reserve the courts in advance for special events and tournaments.

10) Full Colony Club Members will be charged a fee of \$10 per guest for either singles or doubles play. A guest may visit up to a total of three (3) times per month. Each member is responsible for signing in his/her guest at The Colony Club front desk and paying applicable guest fees prior to going on court.

11) For Tennis Members, a guest may visit up to a total of ten (10) times per calendar year. Each member is responsible for signing in his/her guest at The Colony Club front desk and paying applicable guest fees prior to going on court. Tennis Members are allowed one (1) complimentary guest per month. For additional guests, Tennis Members will be charged a fee of \$20 per guest for either singles or doubles play.

12) Only the professionals contracted by The Ritz-Carlton, Half Moon Bay, are permitted to teach on The Colony Club's tennis and pickleball courts.

13) All tennis courts shall be used strictly for tennis and pickleball courts strictly for pickleball, except for special events managed by the Tennis and Pickleball Professionals.

14) No food or beverages other than water are allowed on the courts.
